- 1. How to Give Feedback in a constructive fashion? (Three positives for each criticism)
- 2. How to Hire a new Faculty? (Nice first; No Red Flags)

- **4. How to Discipline unprofessional behavior?** (Know when not to meet alone with your Faculty member)
- **5. How to Close a Program?** (Listen carefully; plan details; everyone appreciates the thoughtfulness)

 (Document; speak with Human Resources and your Chairperson)
- 7. How to know if the job is the right fit?

 (Find a mentor to meet with to review your job satisfaction and career goals; attend AADCAP)
- **8.** How to find opportunities to remain a teacher above all? (Work closely with the Training Director to remain involved with the trainees)
- 9. How to set a warm and supportive tone for a Division? (Model mutual respect among Team Players)
- 10. How to care for yourself in order to remain effective and available?
